The new board member should also benefit from a structured induction process to bring them up to speed as soon as possible. Dependent upon the information and processes which have preceded the board member's appointment, the induction procedure could include some or all of the following:

- > A meeting with the Chair to clarify board roles, expectations, strategic issues
- > Opportunities to meet with other board members individually or collectively
- > A meeting with the CEO to learn about the key personnel, the range of operations, issues currently facing the organisation
- > A visit to the organisation's premises, along with an opportunity to meet some of the staff
- > An invitation to see the organisation's activities and programs in action
- > A follow-up meeting with either Chair or CEO for clarification of any of the material in the Induction Pack
